

ORDINANCE NO. 01-2025

BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER

CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 3, TITLED "ADMINISTRATIVE CODE" OF THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST CHESTER, SPECIFICALLY SECTION 3-38.U(3), TITLED "TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TAC)" TO REQUIRE A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS TO BE BOROUGH RESIDENTS AND ONE MEMBER TO BE ON THE COMMITTEE TO REESTABLISH RAIL SERVICE TO WEST CHESTER.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted by authority of the Council of the Borough of West Chester, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 3 of the Code of the Borough of West Chester, titled "Administrative Code," Section 3-38.U(3), titled, "TRANSPORTATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE (TAC)," shall be amended as follows:

"U. (3) Membership and terms of office. The Transportation Advisory Committee shall be organized as follows:

- (a) The TAC shall consist of five to seven members, comprised of West Chester area residents who utilize public transportation in the Borough or have experience in the public transportation industry, and West Chester University students. A majority of the TAC members shall be residents of the Borough.
- (b) The members shall be appointed by Borough Council to serve staggered two or three year terms.
- (c) The terms of not more than three members shall expire each year. Therefore, unless a vacancy occurs, the Borough Council shall annually appoint no more than three members to the TAC.
- (d) Should a vacancy occur, the Borough Council shall appoint a member to fill the vacancy only for the unexpired portion of the term.

- (e) One member of the TAC shall also be a member of the Committee to Reestablish Rail Service to West Chester and shall serve as a liaison for both Committees.”

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY. If any sentence, clause, section, or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts hereof. It is hereby declared as the intent of Council of the Borough of West Chester that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid sentence, clause, section, or part thereof not been included therein.

SECTION 3. REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances conflicting with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as the same affects this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment as provided by law.




